Cupcake Wars- June 19- 2:00-3:30pm

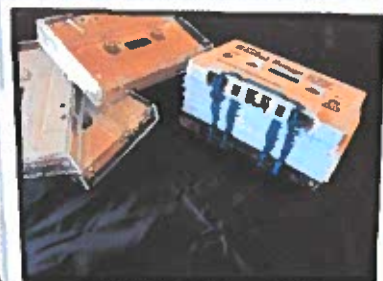
It's an artistic battle... with FOOD. Use the provided supplies to create the best cupcake of them all. And, of course, you get to eat the results.



Cassette Tape Notebooks-

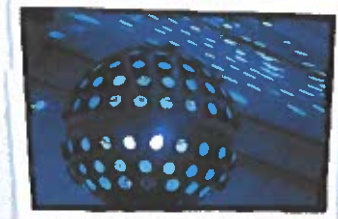
June 26 - 2:00-4:30pm

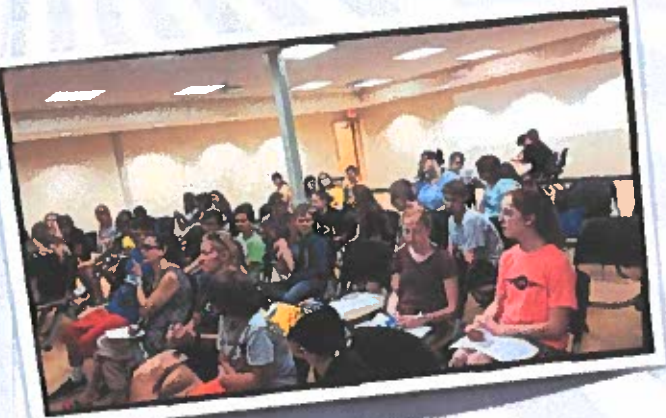


End of Summer Reading Auction - July 24 @ 2:00 pm
